The relevant dates and RP457c CL2 support commitments are detailed below.

2_Rationale

Payment devices (hardware) and POS applications (software) are evolving technologies. They follow a natural product life cycle. Payment hardware is primarily governed by the Payment Card Industry Security Standards Council's (PCI SSC) regulatory compliance requirements, in addition to market activity and market demand.

In this specific case, the main drivers for announcing this EOL of the RP457c CL2 are:

- EOL of the Moby/M70 which was the main factor to keep RP457c still available
- Transition completed to Moby/5500 for majority of active customer
- Limited volumes preventing to position procurement of LLT components, currently at 50 Weeks
